Why do I need to contribute towards the Marine Ambulance?

The St John Ambulance & Rescue Service receives an annual grant from the States of Guernsey to assist with the road ambulance service but the marine ambulance, the inshore rescue boats and other rescue activities of the service, are funded by public generosity through donations and bequests.

The marine ambulance* Flying Christine III was built from funds donated to the Service. Continued donations enable a modern, fully equipped vessel, crewed with paramedics to provide medical treatment and patient transfers to the smaller Islands of the Bailiwick and surrounding waters. Each response costs the Service approximately £2000 and this subscription scheme will go some way to ensure that the on-going running costs and staffing can be met in the coming years.



* "Marine Ambulance" includes any vessels used by the Service in lieu of the Flying Christine III when she is unavailable.

What is the Marine Ambulance Subscription Scheme?

An invitation to support the Flying Christine III, in exchange for which you will not be charged if you need an ambulance response, treatment or transfer during the subscription period.

How do I become a member or renew?

Fill in the application form and post it with your payment or your Direct Debit details to the Ambulance & Rescue Service. Your receipt will be posted back to you (please allow 14 days).

Benefits of membership

Members of the scheme are not charged should they need:

- a response by the marine ambulance service;
- assessment, diagnosis or treatment by ambulance staff;
- transfer by marine ambulance to Guernsey and ambulance vehicle in Guernsey in the event of an injury, serious illness, maternity or other serious medical condition; or under the direct instructions of a Health Care Professional or, if in Sark, the designated Sark Doctor, where they are unfit to travel by any other means for treatment.



No limit to number of responses and no age limit

What does it cost?

SINGLE subscription of £88 provides cover for a single person, with or without children. Any children living with a single parent are included at no extra charge until they leave full time education.

FAMILY subscription of £132 provides cover for a couple, with or without children. Any children living with the couple are included at no charge until they leave full time education.

CORPORATE RATE A corporate rate is available for organisations that employ seasonal workers – price on application.

Rates valid until end 2011

What if I don't join?

The marine ambulance responding to an emergency call will attract a minimum charge of £500 for each response. A non-emergency transfer by marine ambulance booked in advance by a Health Care Professional or if in Sark, the designated Sark Doctor, will attract a minimum charge of £300.

Restrictions

There is no limit to the number of marine ambulance responses, and no age limit for subscribers. Subscribers however cannot order the marine ambulance just because they are members, calls must come from a Health Care Professional or, if in Sark, the designated Sark Doctor.

Private Medical Insurance

If you are covered by a Private Medical Insurance you will need to make a claim through the normal process. You will be invoiced for the full amount to enable you to make a claim from your Insurers.

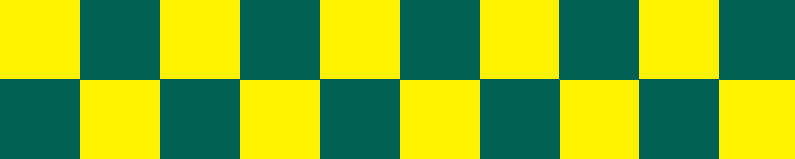

The Direct Debit Guarantee

- The Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instruction to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, The States of Guernsey Treasury and Resources Department will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request The States of Guernsey Treasury and Resources Department to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by The States of Guernsey Treasury and Resources Department or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when The States of Guernsey Treasury and Resources Department asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please notify us.
